FOREST GROVE OPERATIONS PLAN - Oregon

We strive to manage the forest sustainably, so that the benefits from the forest can be delivered into perpetuity The forest harvesting is planned at a sustainable level; a level that our computer models suggest can be harvested year after year without reduction Forest habitat is expected to develop so the forest has a mixture of habitat types

THE CLASSIFIED FOREST AND WILDLANDS PROGRAM

are entered in the Classified Forest and Wildlands program after June 30, 2006 are subject to an additional withdrawal penalty of \$100 per withdrawal and \$50 per acre withdrawn Classified properties that are divided into 2 or more separate tracts must maintain at least 100 acres of eligible land in each tract to remain classified
